We talk about books, authors, characters, and it is lots of fun and a chance to promote literacy and reading and helps kids get excited about books and reading. Last year our team of 4 won our first round of the Kids Lit Quiz at Sir Adam Beck, and we went on to the semi finals at McMaster University. It was amazing to see our four students up on stage, pressing the buzzer and answering the questions. We had a one in 7 chance of winning a trip to the finals in South Africa! We didn't win but it was a very meaningful experience.</p> <p>This year, word has spread about how cool the Kids Lit Club is and we have had a huge interest so far. We had 27 students come our first week and 26 our second. It is so rewarding to see so many students passionate about reading! This year, we would love to be able to register 2 teams to compete. The cost to register is \$125 per team. So we were looking to request \$250. We also talked about perhaps doing a used book sale with the club to raise some funds as well so those could be used even to register a 3rd team depending on how much we would raise. The competitions are held end of January, beginning of February. Our school has so many wonderful offerings for students. Many of them are sports related and this club offers students a chance who may not be as into sports to still have a place for their interest to be met, and for them to find like minded friends.
