The Alphabet Sounds Teaching Tubs include a comprehensive set of <b>26 durable letter tubs (A–Z), 156 miniature objects</b> representing six beginning-sound items per letter, and a full set of uppercase and lowercase plastic letters, along with upper- and lowercase sticker labels for each tub. The kit also includes a detailed teacher's guide offering structured lessons, games, phonemic-awareness activities, and instructional ideas to support early literacy. The miniatures (such as igloos, quilts, yo-yos, x-rays, and other engaging objects) promote hands-on exploration, vocabulary development, letter recognition, sound isolation, and storytelling, making the set ideal for literacy centers and differentiated instruction. To support long-term organization and student independence, the accompanying Teaching Tubs Storage Rack provides a sturdy, lightweight metal frame that holds up to 30 tubs, includes a carrying handle for easy transport, and measures approximately 18" tall × 25" wide, ensuring all components are neatly stored, visible, and accessible.  <i>Please be as detailed as possible. Reason for expense: The Alphabet Sounds Teaching Tubs and Storage Rack are high-impact literacy resources that will support a large number of students across multiple Kindergarten classes for many years. The tubs provide a multisensory approach to teaching letter sounds, blends, vocabulary, and early phonemic awareness—skills foundational for all early learners, including those who benefit from

tactile, visual, and play-based learning. Because the miniatures and structured activities lend themselves to whole-class lessons, small-group instruction, and shared literacy centers, this resource will be used daily and will directly support both current and future cohorts. It is also durable and reusable, making it a long-term investment for the entire Kindergarten division rather than a single-class item. However, due to its cost, this resource exceeds the annual classroom budget provided by SAC, which is why we are requesting financial support through the School Council Disbursement Proposal.
