Expense Description:  <b>\$580</b> to supplement the fee for Dr. Molade Osibodu to prepare and present a 2-hour workshop for all Lanor parents. The interactive workshop aims to inspire parents to engage with their children and math positively. Ms. Bryan went to a workshop of Dr. Osibodu's and highly recommended her.    Dr. Osibodu's is an Associate Professor of Mathematics Education in the Faculty of Education. A former secondary mathematics teacher in South Africa, her research interrogates the enduring impacts of coloniality in [math] education, with a focus on the lived experiences of Black youth and educators in both Canada and Sub-Saharan Africa. Grounded in decolonial frameworks, Black geographies, and participatory research methodologies, her scholarship explores how mathematics curriculum, policy, and pedagogy are shaped by eurocentric and racialized structures.  Dr. Osibodu's work spans three intersecting lines of inquiry: the experiences of Black youth in mathematics classrooms, the colonial foundations of curriculum including international education curricula, and the influence of popular culture on perceptions of mathematical belonging.
