<p>Expense Description:</p> <p>Lanor currently owns 29 Classical Yamaha guitars. 18 of them are working but need to be cleaned and re-strung with new strings. The other 11 guitars are in complete disrepair (unplayable).</p> <p>The quote for new strings and re-stringing services for 18 guitars is \$1,229.44 (including HST).</p> <p>The quote for 10 new Classical Yamaha guitars @169.00 each is \$1,909.70 (including HST)</p> <p>The total quote is estimated at \$3139.14</p> <p>*Long and MacQuade give a special TDSB music teacher discount that has been applied to all the numbers shown above.</p>
<p>Reason for Expense:</p> <p>Guitar Club</p> <p>Last school year I led a grade 7-8 Guitar Club with 12 students. This school year, I am leading a Grade 6-8 Guitar Club with 18 students. Many grade 5s were asking if they could join the Guitar Club and I had to turn them down because we don't have enough working guitars. The guitar is a popular instrument for J-I students at Lanor not only for learning to play chords (e.g., folk, pop, hip hop, rock), but also for composing music.</p> <p>Grade 6-8 Survey</p>

I did a survey and most Lanor students in grades 6-8 want to learn to...

- play the guitar (or keyboard),
- play the drums, and
- compose and/or arrange music.

Grade 6-8 Music Program

This year students have been doing a lot of composing. The grade 7/8s composed Blues songs and now they are composing music for a music scene or trailer. The grade 5/6s began the year with a musical theatre unit, but are much more engaged in a unit where they compose music for movies or compose an anthem song for an invented country.

I would like to be able to teach grade 6-8 students guitar during regular music class time to support their interests (e.g., learning chords for folk, pop, hip hop and rock songs) then take their knowledge of chords to compose music.

If every grade 6-8 student had a guitar in their hands, I could teach them to play the guitar during regular music class time during term 1. During term 2, they could take their knowledge (e.g., I-IV-V chord) of the guitar and confidently write songs.

My goal is to help the students at Lanor feel confident playing an instrument (guitar), confident signing up for Band or Strings in grade 7/8, and confident choosing chord changes when writing compositions.

Music curriculum expectations for grades 5-8 can be covered playing the guitar and music curriculum expectations for grades 1-5 can be covered playing the ukulele.

We have a class set of ukuleles, recorders and other off instruments (e.g., xylophones, metalophones, glockenspeils) for Primary and Junior students.

We are lacking an instrument to use during General Music class time that is accessible to all. The guitar is an excellent instrument choice for Junior - Intermediate General Music students. There is high student interest in learning elements of music and music curriculum expectations through the guitar.
